CHAPTER - III

EXAMINATION (GENERAL)

1. Every candidate for a degree shall, except when exempted by any of the Ordinances, be enrolled as member of an affiliated college before entering upon the course prescribed for such degrees.
2. No candidate who wishes to enter upon a course prescribed for a degree, shall be admitted to an affiliated college unless he has (i) passed the intermediate Examination of the Board of High School and Intermediate Education, Uttar Pradesh, or of an Indian University incorporated by any law for the time being in force. or (i) passed any other examination recognised by the University as equivalent thereto.

NOTE- For purpose of this Ordinance the High School Certificate Examination conducted by the Syndicate of Cambridge University, General Certificate of Education Examination (Advanced) of London University, the Pre Medical Travancore University, the Central Board of Secondary Education, Ajmer, the Board of Secondary Education Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh have been recognised as equivalent to the Intermediate Examination of the Board of High School and Intermediate Education U.P.

7. A regular candidate (other than an Ex-student) preparing in an affiliated college for any examination of the University shall submit his / her application with the prescribed fee at the time of admission or up to August 31st to November 15 of the year preceding the examination:

- (a) Pay into the office of the Registrar the prescribed fee for such examination.
- (b) Provided that the Vice-Chancellor may permit a candidate to submit the application form of examination on payment of additional fee as penalty in special circumstances.

The fee for degree is included in final examination. In case a candidate failed, the fee for degree shall not be charged again.

Enrolment fee Rs. 50/- is included in the fee of examinations of B.A./ B.Sc./ B.Com., B.Sc.

- (c) Along with his / her application for admission, furnish the Registrar with a certificate from the principal of his/ her affiliated college certifying that he/ she has fulfilled the conditions laid down by the University and is of good character.
- (d) If any student requires the transcript of marksheet of any examination he has to pay the fees as follows.

First copy of transcript Rs. 1000/-

Second copy of each transcript of Rs. 200/-

8. The following fees shall be paid in respect of examinations held by the university as prescribed by the Government / Executive Council.

9. Only regular student is allowed to offer dissertation in Post graduate examination if he has secured 55% marks in the Previous Examination. Private student shall not be allowed to offer dissertation at any condition. The candidate who adopts the dissertation as an optional paper in M.A. Final Examination has to pay Rs. 500/- Fees as dissertation fee, along with examination fees.

All dissertations must reach the Registrar by 30th day of April in the session After 30th day of April the following late fee shall be chargeable from the students.

From 1st May up to 15th May Rs. 500/-

From 16th May to 31st May Rs. 1000/-

From 1st June to 15th June Rs. 1500/-

After 15th day of June of the session no dissertation shall be entertained for evaluation.

- 10. A candidate when applying for admission to one or more subsequent examinations shall pay the prescribed fee for such examination on each occasion on which he applies for admission.
- 11. Upon receipt of the fee prescribed the Registrar shall, if the candidate is admitted, furnish the candidate with an admission card permitting him to appear at the examination.
- 12. Permission to appear at University Examination may be withdrawn on the ground of

conduct when the opinion of the Executive Council justifies the candidate's expulsion. In the examination Hall the candidates shall be under the disciplinary control of the Superintendent of the Centre and they shall obey his instructions. In the event of a candidate's disobeying the instructions of the superintendent, on for his insolent behaviour towards the Superintendent or any of the Invigilators, the candidate may be excluded from the day's examination, and if he/ she persists in misbehaviour, he/she may be excluded from the rest of the examination by the Superintendent of the Centre.

If a person is found impersonating for a candidate, the Superintendent of Examination Centre may hand him over to the police for necessary action.

Provided that in all such cases a full report of each case shall be sent to the University and the Examination Committee may according to the gravity of the offence, further punish a candidate by cancelling his/her examination and/ or debarring him/her from appearing at the examination of the University for one or more years.

The Vice - Chancellor and the Registrar shall have powers to authorise a person/ persons to conduct a physical search of the examinees, even without any prior information, in an Examination Hall/ Room at an Examination Centre of the University prior to commencement of an Examination or during the Examination hours. If an examinee refuses to allow the physical search by the authorised person/ persons of the University or misbehave with the authority concerned he/she shall be liable to such disciplinary action and punishment as the University may deem fit under the provisions of this ordinance of the University.

If a candidate is found guilty of using or attempting or helping another candidate to use unfair means or is found guilty of the breach of rules, regulations and ordinances laid down by the University from time to time or commits an act of indiscipline or misbehaves or indulges into any nefarious activities inside and/ or outside the examination hall towards an official engaged in performing duties like, superintendence, invigilation, inspection etc. in connection with the conduct of the University Examination or a report is made as to any candidate or candidates having copied either from some books or notes or from the answer of another candidate or in any indiscipline activities their results shall be cancelled and he or she/ they may further be debarred by the Examination Committee from appearing at the examination of the University for one or more year according to the nature of the offence of the candidate (s).

Provided that when the University intends to award any of the penalties mentioned in its Ordinance it shall give an opportunity to the candidate concerned to show cause in writing, within a week from the date on which the letter is served on him/ her, as to why the proposed penalty may not be imposed on him/ her and shall consider the explanation, if any, if filed within the specified time, before awarding the penalty.

The Examination Committee may cancel the examination of a candidate and/ or debar him/ her from appearing at an examination of the University for one or more years if it is discovered afterwards that the candidate was in any manner guilty of misconduct in connection with his/her examination and or was instrumental in the tampering of

University records including the answer books, mark sheets, result charts, diplomas and the like.

Provided that no such action shall be taken until the candidate has been given a reasonable opportunity of showing cause against the action proposed to be taken in regard to him/ her.

The examinations Committee may delegate its power to the Vice-Chancellor to deal with cases covered under this Ordinance.

13. The Examination Committee may cancel the examination of a candidate and / or debar him / her from appearing at an examination of the University for one or more years, if it is discovered afterwards that the candidate was not eligible to appear at the examination by reason of having misrepresented facts or by submitting false certificates or by forging documents.
14. The Registrar may withdraw the permission granted by some accidental mistake or omission to a candidate who was not eligible for appearance at any University examination even though an admission card, as mentioned in Ordinance, has been issued and produced by him/ her before the Superintendent.
15. A candidate may not be admitted into the examination unless he produces to the officer conducting the examination, his examination admission card.
16. No student shall be allowed to appear at University examinations— B.A., B.Sc., B.Com., B.Sc. (Ag.) examinations— unless he has attended atleast 75 percent both of the lectures delivered and of the practical work done in each subject during the course of instruction for the examination.

In the case of candidate, who has completed the regular course of study for two years and is debarred from appearing at the examination owing to shortage of attendance, percentage shall be counted for the one year only at the end of which the candidate appears at a subsequent examination.

Provided that in the case of an N.C.C. Cadet, only 70% attendance will be required if the Officer Commanding of the Unit certifies that he has attended not less than 70% of the parades during the session.

NOTE :- For the purpose of this Ordinance, attendance by a Cadet at N.C.C. camps or in Mountaineering courses at the Himalayan Mountaineering Institute, Darjeeling, Western Himalaya, Mountaineering Institute, Manali during the session will be deemed as full attendance at college for these days and in the case of those students who are absent from their classes while representing the University and / or the college concerned at the Youth Festival organised by the Government of India or the State Government or while participating in the University Zonal and Inter Zonal Sports, they will be deemed as present in the college for the period of their absence on this account ; provided that such absence does not exceed 20 days in the academic session or 100% of the total attendance required whichever is more.

Provided further that for special reason a shortage of percentage not exceeding 15

percent of total number of lectures delivered or practical work done in each subject may be condoned for sufficient reason.

- (i) A shortage up to 5% of the total number of lectures delivered or practical work done in each subject may be condoned by the Principal of the college concerned for sufficient reason.
- (ii) A further shortage up to 10% may be condoned by the Vice-Chancellor on the specific recommendation of the Principal of the college concerned.
- (iii) For the purpose of these Ordinances not more than two lectures in the same subject, except in the case of post-graduate classes, shall be counted on any one day provided that the attendance at any lecture delivered within 15 days preceding the first day of the University examination shall not count towards the required percentage.

NOTE :- The attendance of the candidate appearing at the University examinations as regular students of colleges shall be counted for the whole of the session, and in no case will a candidate be allowed provisional admission to any course of the University and count attendance from a date other than the date of commencement of the session in that college, except that in the case of candidates who appear at the examination of the University or of any other recognised Indian University or Board of Intermediate Education and whose results are declared not later than 10th September of the year preceding the annual examination, attendance shall be counted from the date of declaration of the result of the Examination concerned.

17. The Registrar may, if satisfied that Examination Admission Card has been lost or destroyed, grant on payment of a further fee Rs. 5/- a duplicate Examination Admission Card. The card so granted shall show in a prominent place the number and date of the card originally granted.
18.
 - (i) The fee shall not be refunded except when a candidate dies before he finishes his part of the examination or is not permitted by the University to appear at the examination.
 - (ii) In the case of candidate whose application is rejected their fee shall be refunded after deducting 25% amount of the fee.
19.
 - (i) Any candidate, who has appeared at the examination conducted by the University may apply to the Registrar for the scrutiny of his marks and the re-checking of his result. Such application must be made so as to reach the Registrar within one month of the date of the examination concerned or date notified by the University.
 - (ii) All such applications must be accompanied by a fee of Rs. 250/- per paper or as prescribed by University.
 - (iii) A candidate shall not be entitled to a refund of the fee.
 - (iv) The result of the scrutiny shall be communicated to the candidate and the names of those candidates whose results are affected shall be published in a supplementary list.

20. Duplicate of University certificates or diplomas shall not be granted except in cases in which the Vice-Chancellor is satisfied by the production of an affidavit on a stamp paper of proper value required by law for the time being in force, that the applicant has lost his/ her certificate or diploma, or that it has been destroyed, and the applicant has real need for a duplicate. In such cases, duplicate of a certificate or Diploma, the original of which was signed by the Vice-Chancellor, will be issued on a payment of a fee of Rs. 150/-. A second duplicate of certificate or diploma shall not be granted under any circumstances.

NOTE – The affidavit referred to above must be verified by the First Class Magistrate or a Notary Public.

- (i) If a candidate has not taken the original Diploma within ten years after the date of the University convocation of the year in which the candidate passed the examination he/ she will not be entitled to get the original diploma from the University. However, if a candidate desires to have a duplicate of the same he/ she may be given a duplicate diploma on payment of a fee of Rs. 200/-.
- (ii) A candidate can get his/ her surname changed in the University Diploma after getting the certificate for passing the Examination on payment of a fee of Rs. 50/-. Provided that original first name of the candidate will remain as in High School Certificate.
21. Any graduate of University may after the declaration of his result and before the date of next Convocation apply to the Registrar for a provisional certificate for passing an examination of the University. Such application shall be accompanied by a fee of Rs. 150/-.
22. Duplicate copies of the following certificates shall be granted on payment of the fee as prescribed for the original certificates :-
- (i) Migration Certificate.
- (ii) Provisional Certificate.
- (iii) Duplicate copy of marks can however be had on remittance of Rs. 50/-.

Provided that in case where the Registrar is satisfied that the original certificate/ marksheet was miscarried in post and did not reach the applicant, a duplicate copy may be issued free of charge.

Provided further that duplicate copies of Migration Certificate shall not be granted except in cases in which the Registrar is satisfied by the production of an affidavit on a stamp paper of proper value required by law for the time being in force that the applicant has not utilized the original migration certificate for appearing at an examination or has lost the same or that the same has been destroyed and that the applicant has real need for a duplicate.

23. A private candidate or Ex-student, who has once taken an optional paper / subject in any examination of the University shall be allowed the same paper / subject when he reappears at any subsequent examination within two years if that paper/ subject forms part of the syllabus.

Provided that this ordinance shall not apply to women candidates offering Indian Music as an optional subject in B.A. Examination.

24. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Ordinance –

- (i) No candidate shall be admitted to an examination of the University for a Bachelor's degree, unless he has passed the Intermediate Examination of a Board of High School and Intermediate Education U.P. or of an Indian University incorporated by an act of Legislature for the time being in force, or any other examination recognised by the University as equivalent thereto in all the compulsory and optional subjects ordinarily required for such an examination.

Provided that a candidate, who has passed an * oriental examination recognised * for the purpose by the Executive Council and also the Intermediate Examination in English conducted by the U.P. or Rajputana Board or by an Indian University incorporated by an act of Legislature for the time being in force or any other examination recognised for the purpose by the Executive Council.

- (ii) No graduate shall be admitted to a post-graduate examination of the university unless he has passed the examination for Bachelor's degree (B.A., B.Sc. or B.Com.) in all the compulsory and optional subjects ordinarily required for such an examination.

Provided that a candidate, who has passed an *Oriental examination recognised for the purpose by the Executive Council and also the B.A. Examination in English Language and also one of the other subjects comprised under the Faculty of Arts, except Modern Indian or Oriental Classical Language, conducted by this University or by any Indian University recognised for the purpose by the Executive Council, may be allowed, if otherwise eligible to appear at the M.A. (Previous) examination of the University in the subject of the Oriental examination or related to it or in that subject in which the candidates passed B.A. Examination along with English Language.

- (iii) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Ordinances, no member of the Executive Council or of a Board of Studies shall be admitted to an examination of the University, except with the special permission of the Vice-Chancellor.

25. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Statutes, Ordinances and Regulations, blind person taking up any examination of the University shall be exempted from the payments

The following more facilities will be provided to blind students, to appear at the University Examination :-

- (i) They will be allowed half-an-hour more than the scheduled time for an examination.
 - (ii) They shall be permitted to appear in the subject of Music as a private candidate for their first degree examination if no arrangement for the same exists in the college where they study.
26. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Ordinances of the University, the principals of colleges, may detain from taking the University Examination such students as do not pay outstanding college dues or return college property and all the articles and uniforms issued to them for Physical Training, N.C.C. or P.E. or pay the cost thereto in case of loss, by February 15 preceding the University Examination.
27. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Ordinances relating to enrolment or admission of candidates to University Examination, the Vice-Chancellor may, in special cases in which he is satisfied that it will be a great hardship to the candidate if his/her application is rejected, entertain an application accompanied with Migration Certificate or enrolment or admission to examination even though the same is received after the due date.

 - (ix) The Alankrit Examination of Kanya Gurukul, Dehradun for admission to M.A. (Previous) Examination on Hindi.

28. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Ordinance of University, every student of the University or of an affiliated college shall pay Rs. 100/- per annum as Allumini fee to the University. The Amount shall be realised by the principals of the respective colleges along with the college fees for the month of July and remitted to the University within a month of the students joining college in the session.
29. The Registrar, after obtaining the Vice-Chancellor's permission, shall have the power to rectify any clerical error or omission discovered after declaration of University Result but before award of the degree, and the mistakes so rectified shall be reported to the Executive Committee at its next meeting for approval.
