Advertisement for Fellowship on CSIR sponsored project

Applications are invited for one post of Research Associate/ Senior Research Fellow/ Junior Research Fellow on CSIR sponsored project entitled “**Evaluation of Antidiabetic Potential of *Momordica dioica* in Wistar Rats**”. Dr. Rambir Singh, Reader, Department of Biomedical Sciences, Bundelkhand University, Jhansi is Principal Investigator of this project. The post is purely temporary coterminous with the project. The project is likely to be completed by 22.01.2013 or as per CSIR guidelines. There is only one fellowship i.e RA/SRF/JRF. The position will be filled based on suitable applications received for particular fellowship. The candidates having research experience relevant to the scheme will be given preference. The decision of PI for filling a particular fellowship will be final.

The qualifications and other terms & conditions for the fellowship are given as under:

Junior Research Fellow

Qualifications : M.Sc. in any branch of Life Sciences with 55% marks and passing of NET/GATE test. Non NET/Non GATE candidates need not to apply for JRF.

Upper age limit: 28

Stipend: As per CSIR rule

Senior Research Fellow

Qualifications : MSc in any branch of Life Sciences with minimum 60% marks and at least two years of post MSc research experience as evident from fellowship/ associateship or traineeship and published papers in standard refereed journals.

Upper age limit: 32

Stipend: As per CSIR rule

Research Associate

Qualifications: Doctorate degree in any branch of Life Sciences, relevant to the project.

Upper age limit: 35

Stipend: As per CSIR rule

Note: Candidates who had submitted Ph.D thesis and viva-voce examination is awaited may be appointed as extended SRFs. The qualifications and terms & conditions for extended SRFs are available at www.hrdgcsir.net.in.

Terms & Conditions:

1. The position is purely temporary, contractual on annual basis co-terminus with the tenure of the project. i.e 22.01.2013. Initially the fellow will be appointed for one year and further extension may be given on satisfactory research performance. If a

Fellow/Associate is reported to have been lacking in his or her research assignment, the fellowship/associateship is liable to be terminated by CSIR.

The last date for submission of completed application is **September 30, 2011 to Dr. Rambir Singh, Principal Investigator, Department of Biomedical Sciences, Bundelkhand University, Jhansi-284128, Uttar Pradesh. The name of the project should be mentioned on the envelopes containing application.**
3. The applicants are required to mention the name of project on the envelop.
4. The Application should be typed on plain paper giving full details of educational qualifications, research experience, employment in chronological order and publications. Attested copies of all testimonials should be attached with the application. Candidates are essentially required to enclose copy of research publications.
5. Incomplete applications and applications received after due date will not be considered.
6. The funding agency (CSIR) may change the existing guidelines/formulate new guidelines for the fellowships. The decision of funding agency will be final in every case.
7. Age will be decided on closing date of the advertisement. The age relaxation will be as per norms of government of Uttar Pradesh. State govt. norms will be applicable on the selected fellow.
8. The project is funded by CSIR, candidates are advised to read detailed qualifications and other terms & conditions of fellowship at **www.csirhrdg.res.in**. The appointment of selected candidate is subjected to approval by CSIR.
9. Only Indian citizens are eligible for research fellowship/associateship.
